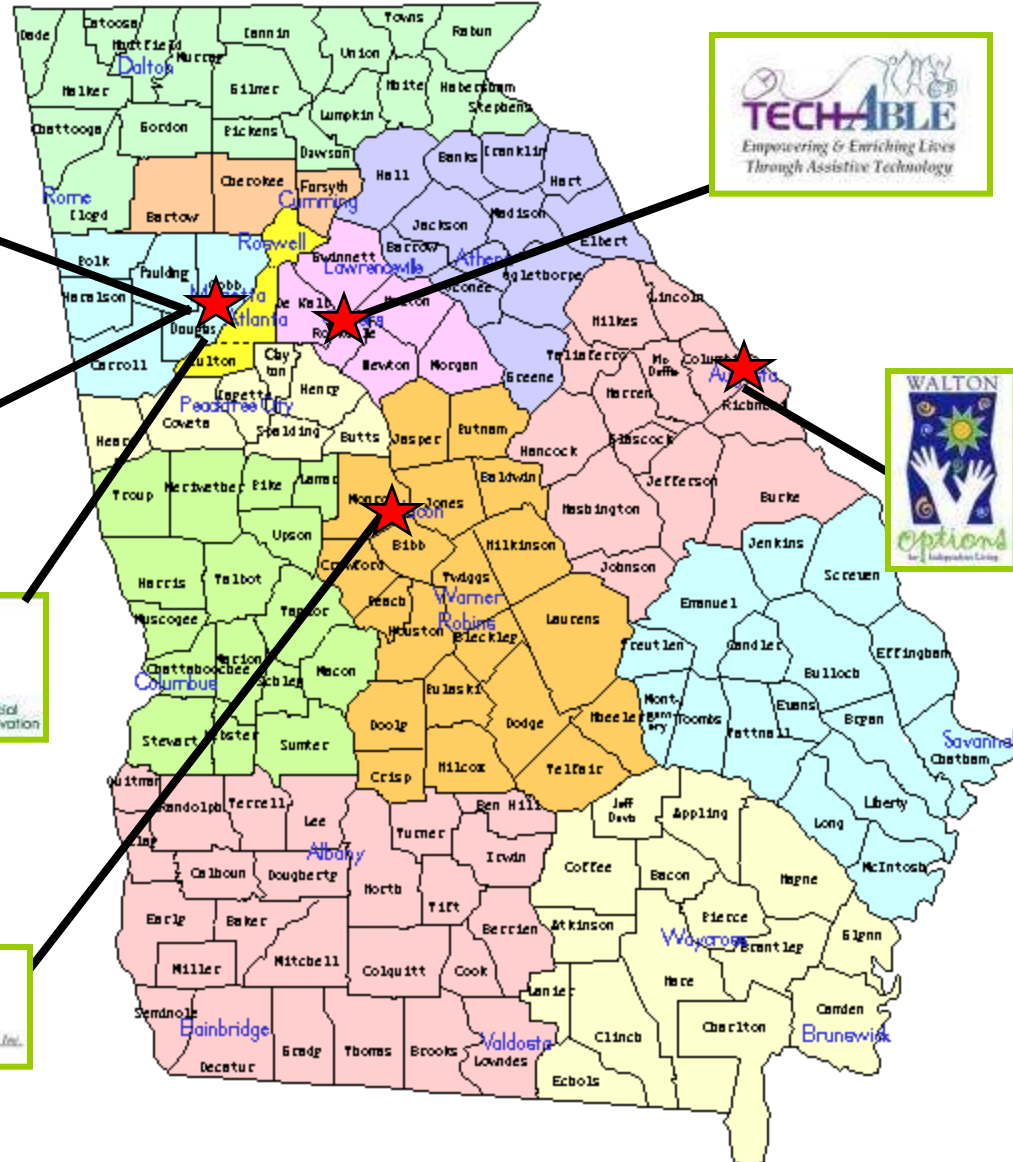

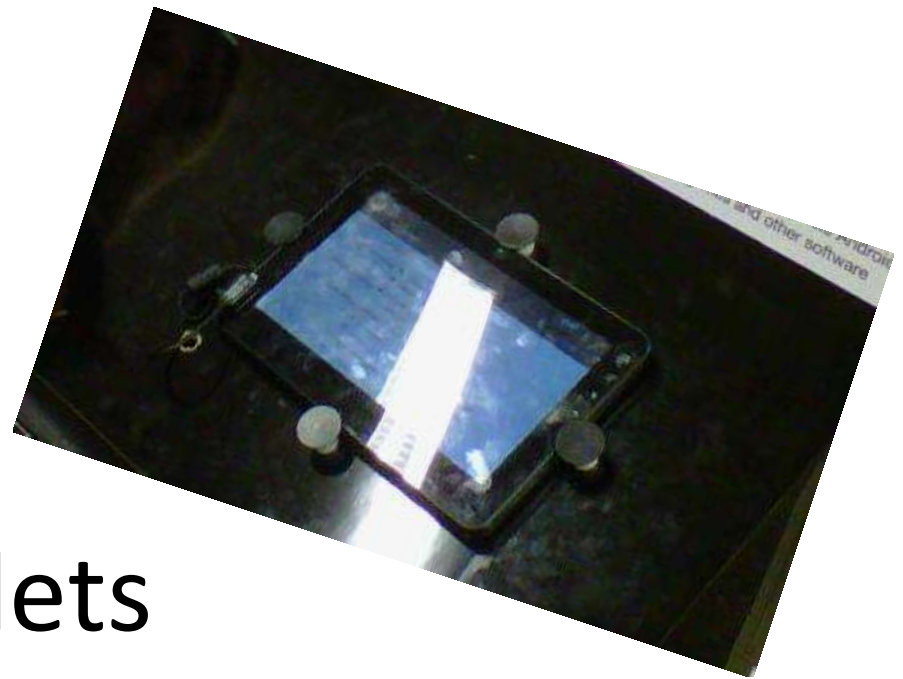
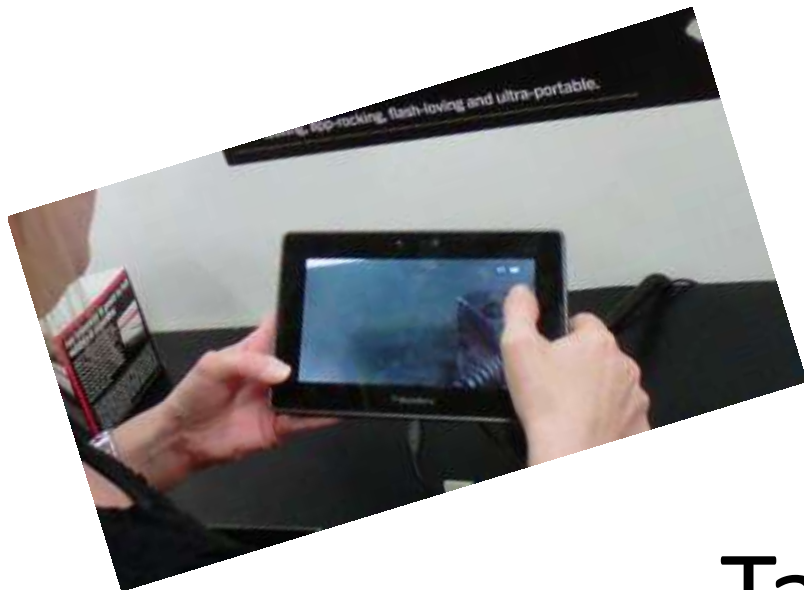

- The act or process of knowing or being aware of thoughts or perceptions; the various thinking skills and processes are considered cognitive skills.
 - **Cognitive Ability** - Intellectual ability; thinking and reasoning skills.
 - **Cognitive Limitation** - Difficulty with one or more of the basic functions of the brain: perception, memory, expression and processing skills.

Noted Orthographic Problems

- Slow to recognize high frequency words
- Slow to recognize exception words
- Confuses similar looking letters/words
- More difficulty with short, common words
- Often loses place
- Slow to read or write words
- Inconsistent spelling of a word in one sample
 - **Becy, Beacey, Beke, beckey**



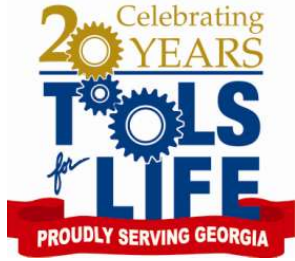
Multi-Modal Supports for Cognition

- Visual, Auditory, Haptic...
- Work with Individual Learning Style
- Focuses on Strengths
- For Example:
 - Auditory information is transient
 - Visual information remains present for as long as you may need it
 - Visuals eliminate the guesswork & make the message clear and concrete



What problems can Multi-modal Input Supports solve?

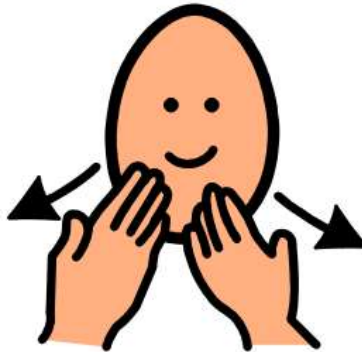

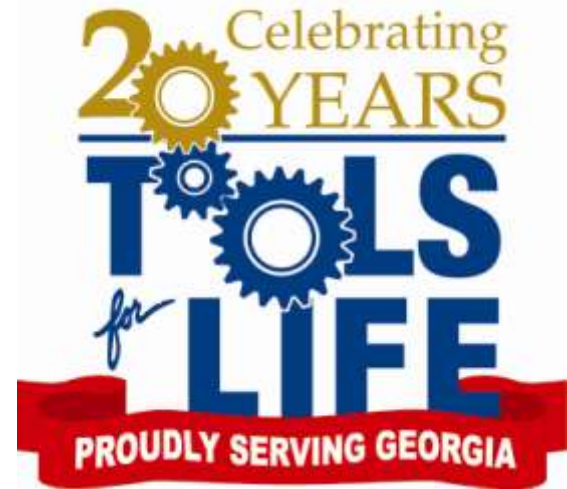
